EXCURSION II.A 27.5.2015

The goal of the excursion was to raise the knowledge of students in the issue of water management.

Students got explained technical details, exact numbers, they were given a guided tour of a hydroelectric dam, a sewage disposal plant, a hydroelectric power station, a drinking water finishing plant and much more important information on the issue of water management.

The excursion took place in the valley of the Svratka river. We started our trip in the village of Dalečín, where we visited the sewage disposal plant. Then we followed the Educational Trail of the Svratka Water Management. There were numerous educational panels describing variety of issues of water management. Water treatment plants
Sewage disposal plants
The water energy usage
